

SITE RULES

GENERAL

- EVERYONE must consider the safety of themselves and others at ALL TIMES
- Contractors must remove their waste from site.
- Dangerous working will result in an hour suspended from the workplace, repeat offenders will be removed from site

TRAFFIC

- Be aware of moving traffic – in the loading areas and forklifts in the hall
- The speed limit is: **5mph** in the loading areas

WELFARE & CLOTHING

- Appropriate footwear must be worn
- High Vis must be worn on the loading areas
- Excessive late working will require additional crews

METHODS OF WORKING

- NO HOT WORK permitted without authorisation from the Organisers
- Appropriate and safe methods of working at height are required at all times

SITE INFORMATION

Organisers' Office

The Organisers' Office is located at the front of the hall.

The onsite office number will be released closer to the show.

First Aid

The Medical Centre is open throughout the tenancy period of the show.

In a First Aid emergency, assistance should be obtained via any member of the show team, security staff or the Organisers' Office or in an emergency call +44 (0) 20 7069 4444.

Toilets

Toilets are located on the Boulevard

Catering facilities

A catering outlet will be open on the Boulevard for the majority of the build-up and breakdown times. When not available there are vending machines.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Fire

On discovering a fire:

- Break glass at nearest fire alarm point.
- Contact the Security Suite – dial 4444, state 'fire' and give them the precise location.
- Only if you have been trained and it is a very minor fire and it is safe to do so, tackle the fire with the nearest suitable fire extinguisher.
- Always ensure there is a safe exit route before attempting to extinguish any fire.
- In the event of a fire report you will hear the following instructions broadcast over the public address system, be prepared to evacuate.

“ATTENTION PLEASE, ATTENTION PLEASE, MR GOODFELLOW REPORT TO THE SECURITY SUITE”- TAKE NO IMMEDIATE ACTION STANDBY FOR FURTHER INSTRUCTION.

Evacuation

If an evacuation is necessary, you will hear the following announcement broadcast over the public address system.

“ATTENTION PLEASE. ATTENTION PLEASE. HERE IS AN IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT. IT IS NECESSARY TO ASK EVERYONE TO LEAVE THE BUILDING. PLEASE MAKE YOUR WAY CALMLY TO THE NEAREST EXIT. EVERYONE WILL BE RE-ADMITTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE”.

Cancellation

The Emergency is cancelled by the announcement:

“ATTENTION PLEASE. ATTENTION PLEASE. STAFF CALL 100 IS CANCELLED.”

Bomb Threat

In the event of a bomb threat, if you are in the halls you will hear the following announcement:

“ATTENTION PLEASE. ATTENTION PLEASE. STAFF CALL 100”

Do not leave the building Inform your colleagues, and then assist in searching for suspicious objects in your work area.

If nothing is found, tell your Fire Warden, who should report “Area clear” to the Security Suite immediately after the search on internal 4444 or in person if necessary.

If you find a suspicious object, do NOT touch or move it. Clear the area of people calmly and report to the Security Suite immediately on internal 4444 or in person if necessary.

IN THE RARE EVENT OF
A firearms or weapons attack

RUN – to a place of safety. This is a better option than to surrender or negotiate. If there's nowhere to go then....

HIDE – Remember to turn your phone to silent and turn off vibrate. Barricade yourself in if you can...

TELL – the police by calling 999 when it is safe to do so.
